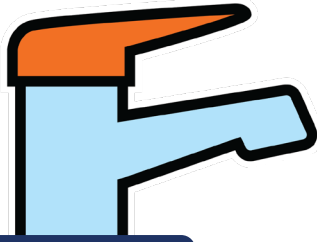


Water Word Rescue
